- Two completed letter of recommendation forms. The people you list as references must complete the letter of recommendation form in the application packet.
- List of your extracurricular activities, honors received, scholastic achievements, employment history, leadership positions, and community service (one side of a 8-1/2 inch x 11 inch piece of paper).
- Proof of acceptance/enrollment at college/university,technical school/trade school.
- Proof of your United States citizenship: photocopy of birth certificate, naturalization papers, or information page of United States Passport. If listed, please blackout social security numbers.
- Current high school transcript. *This scholarship requires a minimum unweighted grade point average (GPA) of* 3.25 based on a 4.0 scale.
- *Incomplete applications will be rejected.*

Purpose: To provide a one-time scholarship of \$2,000 to eligible seniors in Washoe County School District.

Award: At least (5) non-renewable scholarships will be awarded to (5) persons selected by the Sierra Nevada Chapter DAR Scholarship Committee.

Eligibility:

- 1. Applicant must be a senior at a Washoe County High School.
- 2. Applicant must have at least a 3.25 GPA (unweighted).
- 3. Applicant must demonstrate involvement within the school and community.
- 4. Applicant must be graduating from a Washoe County High School in June 2024.
- 5. Applicant must show proof of enrollment from the college, university, or vocational/technical school they plan to attend in **Fall 2024**.
- 6. Applicant must submit ALL completed materials postmarked by the Thursday, February 15, 2024.

- 3. 1,000 word (or less) Student Essay
- 4. Two (2) letter of recommendation forms
- 5. List of extracurricular activities, honors received, scholastic achievements, employment history, leadership positions, and community service
- 6. Proof of acceptance/enrollment at college/university,technical school/trade school
- 7. Proof of citizenship
- 8. Current high school transcript

STUDENT ESSAY REQUIREMENTS: Essays **must be typed**, double-spaced, in 12-point Times New Roman or an equivalent font, with numbered pages, one-inch margins and 1,000 words maximum.

ESSAY PROMPT:

What course of study do you intend to pursue in college or vocational/technical school? What has motivated you to choose this career path? What do you intend to accomplish with your degree? What do you envision yourself doing ten years from now?


